### CASHEL BARN ESSENTIALS

There are always things we really don't actually need, but they make life easier at the barn. That is what Cashel has done, made my life easier! I have found some things that I could certainly have done without but they are indispensable now that I have used them over the last year.

The Velcro brush has become a saddle bag mainstay...It is called the Hook & Loop brush, used to get debris off Velcro. It works so well, I have not had to wash my SMB Boots yet....this scrubs off all the dirt and trail debris from the Velcro closures that always catch everything.

It is only 7.25...worth it's weight in gold!



The Loop-De-Loo is a simple strap with a snap on one end that allows you to tie just about anything to a gate, stall or trailer, etc. You can use it on a saddle to hang from a D-ring or hang tack, buckets, bags, anything, anywhere. Dozens of uses...I keep one in my saddle bag, just in case. It has a loop on one end and the snap on the other. Only 12.95 each....



Cinch Master – this is a great idea...it keeps the cinch ring or billet buckles from pinching. It is a simple neoprene piece that closes with Velcro and just put it around the buckle or cinch and there is no pinching. Small, simple and so necessary! Just 11.95 each.
