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## Clinton Anderson - Correcting Problems on the Trail

This tape is great for everyone to watch. It is helpful even if you have been trail riding for decades! You will see how to SAFELY move through obstacles, logs, hills, gullies, as well as water hazards....

There is also a section on how to help your horse approach and acknowledge lots of "spooky" things like animals, tarps and moving vehicles with ease.....!

You will also see how to prevent lots of issues that are common that can cause fear and distrust...jigging around, tossing the head, kicking, bucking/rearing, running off, herd bound, etc.

In an excerpt, he says that he is addressing all the problems and issues he has heard from riders all across the country and has tried to show how to eliminate fear and worry....

It is a tape that everyone who trail rides should watch. Even if your horse does not exhibit any of these issues, at one time or another he will and you will learn how to avoid them becoming worse. Stop them before they become an obstacle between you...

On a scale of 1-10, this tape rates an 11. Clint is very easy to understand, he talks in layman's terms and is most helpful for those that have not been riding a long time. He uses terms that most horse owners can understand.
